Introduction:

Youth Club is an interest group formed in 2017 by a group of students who are keen to develop themselves, maximising their potential and achieving breakthroughs during this period of self-discovery. This CCA is based on the National Youth Achievement Award (NYAA) model, with a focus on the different aspects - Service, Physical Recreation, Skill, Adventurous Journey and Residential Project. We contribute actively and meaningfully to the society through our weekly mentoring programme at St. Hilda's Link. Through interactions with the children, we are given the opportunities to understand societal issues and are directed to think of what we can do as youth.

We make it a long term commitment to mentor children at St Hilda's Link, where children of different backgrounds and learning needs come together to learn under our companionship. Each one of us partners a child and plays the role of a befriender. We lend support to our mentees when the need for help in studies or life arises. Our mentees spend 2 hours of learning and interaction with us every week and we also plan outings such as sports day, picnics and movies during school holidays for them.

We also participate in a variety of sporting activities such as cycling and basketball. Besides physical recreation, we are also given the chance to pick up new skills, such as dancing and cooking. The nature of our interest group allows plenty of opportunities for leadership and growth, as all activities are enthusiastically piloted and carried out by us. Through serving the community and daring to embark on new adventures, we hope to realise our vision of being a group of proactive individuals which embodies the spirit of youth.
